JQuery: HTML Form - Checking For Non Empty Field

Required Field Validation

The following JQuery Script can be used to check whether user has entered anything in a given field or not. If user submit the form without filling this field the border of text field can be red and form will not submit.

Required Field Validation Example

$(document).ready(function () {
$('#kk').click(function () {
var z = $('#uk').val();
if (z == "") {
alert("Please Enter Name");
```

else {
alert("You have entered" + " " + z);
return false;
}
});
});

How To Make Text Editable Using JQuery

JQuery Example

The following JQuery Script can be used to make text field editable using JQuery with the help of JQuery pre-defined function like text(), show(), hide() and onblur event. See the following example.

JQuery : HTML Form - Submit On Enter

Simple JQuery script to submit form on enter. You can use following script to submit form data on enter button.

  <script src="http://freeonlinecompiler.ptutorial.com/
js/jquery.min.js"></script>
</head>
<body>
<h2>Submit on enter</h2>
  <form id="f" action="uk.php">
<input id="whichkey" type="text">
  </form>
<script>
$("#f").on( "keydown", function( event ) {
var key=event.which;
```



```
var name = $("#whichkey").val();
if(key==13){
if(name=="")
{
alert("You have not entered anything");
}else{
$('#f').submit();
alert("you have entered: "+name);
}
}
});
</script>

</body>
</html>
```
